Entry Criteria: Grade 6 – GCSE Religious Studies. All students must also have achieved a minimum of a GCSE Grade 5 in English Language or English Literature.

What will I study:

Philosophy concerns itself with a study of thought and ideas about reality, the existence of God and what it means to be human. Ethics is a study of how we arrive at decisions about right and wrong, and then applying this to various issues. New Testament Studies analyses the influences and factors that shape the message and interpretation of these famous Sacred Text.
