

## St Philomena's Sixth Form Entrance Requirements 2019

<b>Pathway 1:</b> <b>At least <u>eight</u> GCSEs grades 9-5</b> (minimum of six grade 7 or above)	Students can opt to do 4 A Levels or 3 A Levels and EPQ or Level 3 Maths in Context if applicable
<b>Pathway 2:</b> <b>At least <u>eight</u> GCSEs grades 9-4</b> (minimum of four grade 5 or above)	Students study 3 A Levels (BTEC qualifications may be taken) and Maths in Context if applicable
<b>Pathway 3:</b> <b>At least <u>eight</u> GCSEs grades 9-4</b> (with fewer than four at grade 5)	Students study two Level 3 BTEC qualifications and can study one A Level or a further Level 3 equivalent qualification.
<b>Pathway 4:</b> <b>At least <u>five</u> GCSEs grades 9-4</b> (including grade 4 in English or Maths)	Students study three Level 3 BTEC qualifications and may also retake GCSE Maths or English if they have not achieved a 4 in one or the other.
<b>Pathway 5:</b> <b>Fewer than <u>five</u> GCSEs grades 9-4</b> (below grade 4 in Maths and English Language)	Students follow the Level 2 Hospitality Course and retake both GCSE English and GCSE Mathematics.

GCSE English Language and GCSE Mathematics will need to be continued to be studied in the Sixth Form if a GCSE standard pass of a Grade 4 has not been achieved at the end of Key Stage 4. The school will apply government legislation and guidance and parents and students will be informed of any changes to this policy if they occur within the academic year.

*Please note:- Courses will only be provided if there is a viable number of students enrolled after Results day on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2019. Parents and students will be communicated with by March 2019 if the school believe there is a risk of any subject not being offered.*

Media Studies	1 2 3	Grade 6 – GCSE Media Studies if taken and All students must also have a Grade 6 in English Literature AND/OR Grade 5 in English Language
Music	1 2 3	Grade 6 – GCSE Music. You need to be proficient on at least one instrument to Grade 5. All students must also have achieved a minimum of a GCSE Grade 5 in English Language or English Literature and GCSE Grade 4 in Mathematics
Art & Design Photography	1 2 3	Grade 5 – GCSE Art or GCSE Photography (portfolio for students who have not studied this subject at GCSE)

Physical Education	1 2 3	Grade 6 – GCSE PE and actively engaged in sporting performance or coaching. In addition, a GCSE Grade 5 in Biology or 5, 5 in Combined Science. All students must also have achieved a minimum of a GCSE Grade 5 in English Language or English Literature.

Extended Project Qualification (half an A level)	8 GCSE passes at Grade 9-5 including English Language or English Literature at GCSE Grade 6
Sports Leadership	Students will need to either be studying A level PE or have an interest in sport's leadership or be actively engaged in sporting performance, officiating or coaching.
